Being empathetic, the warmth and caring that people long for and need for recovery. Being a good listener, not interrupting, drawing out a person's story.

Confidentiality developed through trust.

Learning to be your real self when sitting with people.

Looking for the good in people.

Accepting, never judging, being the safe person people need.

Noticing how a person's language reveals what they believe about themselves.

Teaching people the skill of seeing their own thoughts in the moment.

Helping others to doubt the accuracy of long held self beliefs.

Helping people ponder whether these beliefs align with what God thinks.

Helping people to know that every thought needs to be challenged before it is believed.

Allowing God space in the moment to speak to hearts, to renew minds.

Allowing God to bring about change.

That He knows our thoughts from afar. (Psm 139)

That He works within the soul, He can divide even between soul and spirit. (Heb 4:12)
